Election Results

As you all know, Election Day was yesterday. Below is a summary of the results for key statewide races and ballot initiatives as of this morning. Incumbents are marked with an asterisk (*)

State Senate District 1 – Represents parts or all of Alpine, El Dorado, Lassen, Modoc, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sacramento, Shasta, Sierra and Siskiyou counties.
